INTRODUCTION A BRAND NEW DAY

A little more than four years ago, we decided to change our story.

Originally, it was a tale of two protagonist from different worlds. One a seasoned Talent Agent, who was craving to have his own agency. The other a Marketing Executive that was only working in the Comics Scene as a hobby, but wanted to do much more.

With a mutual love of comics, it was a natural team-up we demanded, and that gave birth to **Chiaroscuro Studios**. Now one of the biggest Talent Agencies in the world, we are responsible for managing the careers of over fifty artists in Brazil and around the world. Chiaroscuro Studios produces over 30 comic books per month for the biggest publishers in the industry like DC COMICS, MARVEL, SKYBOUND, DARK HORSE, TITANS COMICS, BOOM! STUDIOS and DYNAMITE ENTERTAINMENT.

Our focus is the artwork for those comic books. What we do is receive the scripts and make them ready for our pencillers, inkers and colors to interpret. The artistic creation for many start right here in Brazil. During 2017, several of Batman's adventures were produced in Belo Horizonte/MG. Justice League saw their epics begin in São Bernardo do Campo/SP. The scripts for The Inhumans were brought to life under the Sun of Recife/PE, and there's many more that are being drawn and colored here south of the equator.

But our vision is going further than comics, the artists we represent produce illustrations for advertising, create designs for licensed collectibles and action figures, work with clients on concept art, and a multitude of different projects for companies around the World.

Chiaroscuro Studios is also the co-creator of CCXP – Comic Con Experience, the biggest comic con to date. In 2017, it attracted 227 thousand avid fans, as well as hosting GameXP, a Gaming show, in partnership with Rock In Rio, which went onto register 361 thousand visitors for 2017. In addition to this event, we recently created and produced an art exhibit at the Memorial da America Latina, in São Paulo celebrating one of our talented artist.

And now the time has come to further take control of the narrative by not just translating others scripts, but by starting to tell our own stories with our own characters!

With **Days of Horror**, we debut our Comics Imprint. We Love challenges, and for this first project, we gathered over 50 artists to pencil, ink and color this unique tribute and homage to classic Super-Hero Comics, written by Danilo Beyruth (Bando de Dois, Astronauta-Magnetar, Ghost Rider).

At the same time, **Days of Horror** works as a portfolio of the talent we represent, displaying the different styles of our people, as they work in unison for the continuity of the story. The editor of the book was Sidney Gusman, known journalist and MSP (Mauricio de Sousa Produções) Editor-In-Chief.

This book you're holding in your hands is the first piece of something greater we're just starting to build. We couldn't thank you enough for being here at the beginning of this special project that is a testament of our ongoing passion and our commitment to Comics!

And our story, like in the grand tradition of the Best Comic Books, is also...

PREFACE

TALENT, DEDICATION & JOY

Good guys. And talented.

Actually, make that great guys, and really talented.

That was how quickly my impression changed soon after meeting the people that make up Chiaroscuro Studios. And the longer I work in comics (which is coming up on 10 years), the more important it is to work with excellent human beings than those that are merely talented assholes. One of Skybound's trade secrets: we don't hire assholes. Life's too short. Assholes aren't fun. And creating and reading comics should—largely—be fun.

Which is all the long way of saying that Joe Prado and Ivan Freitas da Costa have assembled a large roster of talented, fun loving individuals. If you're ever seen them at a convention or shared a meal with them, they just look like they're having more fun than you. (They're **definitely** having more fun than me. **everyone** in comics has more fun than an editor.)

I first met Joe Prado when I was a baby assistant editor at DC, working on *Aquaman*. A title that was about to be relaunched in a huge way with Joe and Ivan Reis on art. The first issue had just been finished and was absolutely gorgeous; their run remains some of the best-looking comics I've ever worked on. Ivan and Joe had just finished *Blackest Night* and were DC's premiere art team. (They still are, for whatever my opinion's worth.) Long story short: Joe and Ivan were in town, I was invited to dinner with them, they welcomed me immediately with a warmth I'd certainly never experienced in comics prior to that... and maybe taught me enough Portuguese to accurately describe different parts of a butt.

I could claim that it's the magic of Brazil, that its artists simply possess a certain joie de vivre... but I don't want to diminish the hard work and passion these individuals put into their art. They've earned their fun. Their talent has infiltrated the American comic industry's top companies. When I left DC for Skybound, one of my first hires was Andrei Bressan. He grew from a superhero fill-in artist on *Suicide Squad* and *Green Lantern: New Guardians* to having just wrapped up his 27th issue of *Birthright* with Josh Williamson. Month after month, Andrei delivers the most metal creatures and insane battles... and always seems eager to one-up himself. (I am also 100% biased. I own more original art by Andrei than any other artist.)

This yearbook is filled with artists that get me excited about comics again in the same way that first working with Andrei did. I've worked with many of them, and look forward to one day working with them again, finding the perfect project to cut loose on.

To steal our catchphrase from Team Aquaman days, the art of Chiaroscuro is so aquaralho.

in Colonial Brazil. I've been working
in comics since 1994, and have
drawn titles such as *Fantastic Four*, *Silver Surfer*, *Star Wars — Empire*, *Witchblade*, *Miss Marvel*, and others.

In 2017, I inked RB Silva in story arcs for the main mutant launches, *X-Men* — *Gold* and *Blue*. Also at Marvel Comics, I was part of the Generations arc, inking pages for *The Phoenix & Jean Grey*. I inked two short stories for the independent publication *The Chronicles of Few and Cursed*, one of them by **Chiaroscuro Studios** colleague José Luís.

I started 2017 doing covers for movie comic adaptations [Re]Assignment and The Girl with the Dragon Tattoo, from Titan Comics. Then I took on pencils and inks for Justice, Inc — The Avenger, from Dynamite Comics, a noir police story. Both incredible experiences that have made this an intense and gratifying year.

Being introduced to the Franco-Belgian market was a special experience, made even more unique by meeting the incredible people there!

In 2017, I drew four pages of *Batgirl and The Birds of Prey* for DC Comics, and I began a story for *Red Sonja* from Dynamite Comics, but unfortunately that project was cancelled. So, it was necessary to reinvent myself: I invested my time in sample pages, commissions and studying new ways of showcasing my work, at the same time attending conventions and preparing a new creator-owned project.

Even though mostly an artist, in 2017, I tried my hand at writing. I finished the script for a creatorowned project that shall be released soon, and took part in an anti-intolerance anthology. I also drew two issues of *Mosaic* from Marvel Comics, and one comic for Marvel Custom Publishing. At the moment, I'm doing pencils, inks, colors and letters for the *Society of Virtue* app.

I also take part in comicbook events and conventions in Brazil and abroad, and coordinate Dínamo Estúdio art school in Porto Alegre, Brazil.

I have drawn for Marvel Comics and DC Comics, but in 2017, I focused on editorial and art coordination for two illustrated prose books in Portugal, where I live: *Contos de Sabedoria* and *Aurora Boreal e O Instinto Supremo*. I also have continued to develop the graphic novel *O Infante Portugal* that was first an exhibition and then partially published in comicbook format.


DANILO BEYRUTH


GUSTAVO DUARTE

MARCELO COSTA


